## 31st Annual AYSO Turkey Tournament Referee Plan



The following are guidelines that will apply to referees for the 31st Annual AYSO Turkey Tournament.

| Commitment<br>Requirements    |    | Each team in the tournament will be expected to cover 9 refereeing slots throughout the tournament. These may be game assignments or standby assignments, which will be considered equal. The Referee Team does not have to referee together as a Team.   |

|                               | В. | Referees and Assistant Referees shall self-assign on the referee scheduling site subject to by the Referee Administrator. RefScheduler.net©   |
| Qualification<br>Requirements | A. | Each referee must be an AYSO registered volunteer, Safe Haven, Concussion, Cardiac Arrest, and Safesport certified.   |
|                               | B. | Each referee must be versed in the Laws of the Game, including current law changes and capable of applying the laws according to the spirit of the game.  |
| Uniform<br>Requirement        | Α. | All referees must be in full Uniform as defined by AYSO or USSF, including the AYSO Badge.  |
|                               | B. | The Gold uniform will be considered the primary color of referee uniform for this tournament. The referee crew will be expected to change to an alternate color in case of conflict with either of the teams' uniforms.   |
|                               | C. | Tournament Field Marshals may stand-in without a uniform if needed and are qualified to be an Assistant Referee   |
| Tournament<br>Rules           | A. | Referees will be expected to familiarize themselves with and uphold the tournament rules, AYSO guidelines and FIFA laws. Any failure of the referee to uphold these rules may be cause for dismissal from the tournament.   |
|                               | В. | Referees will receive gamecards directly from the coaches.  |
|                               | C. | Only the diagonal system of control will be used.   |
|                               | D. | Referees will be expected to fill out the game cards and to keep track of substitutions.  |
|                               | E. | Referees will be expected to note on the back of the game cards and to fill out misconduct reports immediately after the game in which a misconduct (caution and/or send-off) was issued to a player or coach, or if there were spectator interference problems, or any other action that merits a report.  |
|                               | F. | Referees will be expected to turn in all completed game cards to the Field Marshal immediately after each game and notify the Tournament Director of any ejection (player or coach).  |
| Referee<br>Schedules          | A. | Referee schedules will be made available on <a href="RefScheduler.net">RefScheduler.net</a> © the tournament website within 1 week of the tournament. Each team will be expected to ensure that the referee schedule and check-in instructions have been provided to their referee crew.  |
| Use of Local<br>Referees      | A. | Additional referees will be provided by the host region, including from the surrounding regions and Areas to ensure all games are covered by qualified referees. These referees will be provided assignments on a stand-by or fill-in basis. Priority will be given to referee crews.   |
| Assessments                   | A. | The Turkey Tournament will provide referees for opportunities to be assessed for upgrades. These opportunities will be provided. Referee Assessors will be arranged through the local Area or Section staff. To take advantage of this opportunity, referees must register in advance with the Turkey Tournament Referee Administrator (see contact section). |
| Referee<br>Check-In           | A. | All referees will be expected to check in at the Field Marshal Tent upon their arrival at the tournament.   |
|                               | B. | Referees are expected to check in at the Field Marshal Tent at least 30 minutes prior to their assigned game.   |

| Referee<br>Mementos     | <ul> <li>A. Referees will be provided with refreshments including lunch around noon with beverages and snacks also available at the Field Marshal Tent.</li> <li>B. Referees completing one game will receive a flip coin. Referees completing five games or more will also receive a tournament sweatshirt.</li> </ul> |  |
